The University of Delaware invites nominations and applications for the position of Director, Center for Teaching and Assessment of Learning. The University of Delaware, a state-supported, privately managed institution, is located midway between Washington, DC and New York City. The Director oversees the Center, serves as a member of the University accreditation team for the Middle States Commission on Higher Education, and works closely with deans, department chairs and other academic leaders on instruction, assessment and program evaluation. The Director plays an essential role in improving and assessing teaching and learning in undergraduate, graduate and other educational programs across the University. The Director is responsible for the creation and implementation of effective programs to improve student learning outcomes by enhancing instruction and assessment throughout the University.

The successful applicant for the Director of the Center for Teaching and Assessment of Learning will have a Doctoral Degree, preferably in mathematics education, science education, curriculum and instruction, instructional design, assessment or related field, with 5 to 7 years of progressively responsible experience directly related to professional development for enhancing teaching and learning and assessment of teaching and learning, preferably at the university-level. The position requires strong interpersonal and communication abilities, as well as the ability to interact effectively with a broad range of University constituencies. Interested applicants should have familiarity with the policies and procedures of institutional and programmatic accreditation, particularly as they relate to assessment of student learning.

Review of applications will begin on October 1, 2018, although nominations and applications will be accepted until the position is filled. Nominations and expressions of interest will be held in confidence.
