Visiting Assistant Professor in Mathematics Education

The School of Education (SOE) in the College of Human Sciences at Iowa State University invites applications for a full-time, one-year position in mathematics education to teach undergraduate courses in the elementary education program with a start date of August 16, 2019. This is a term position with the possibility of a 1-year renewal and carries a three course per semester teaching load.

Specifically, we are looking for a faculty colleague to: (a) teach undergraduate methods courses in mathematics education in our elementary education program; (b) potentially teach other courses in the educator preparation program; and (c) participate in the life of the School of Education, including program-level meetings, as appropriate.

Iowa State University is classified as a Carnegie Foundation Doctoral/Research University-Extensive, a member of the Association of American Universities (AAU), and ranked by U.S. News and World Report as one of the top public universities in the nation. - (e) Evidence of a commitment in professional practice to equity in education.

Preferred Education and Experiences:

- (a) Endorsement(s) or advanced coursework in elementary mathematics education.
- (b) Experience working in/with the preparation of elementary or secondary school teachers.
- (c) Evidence of effective teaching at the post-secondary level.
- (d) Additional years as a successful elementary teacher.

Salary: Commensurate with qualifications.
