Minimum qualifications include: (1) an earned Ph.D. or Ed.D. in mathematics education or a related field with a minimum 18 graduate credit hours in mathematics; (2) a minimum of one year experience teaching K-12 mathematics. Responsibilities will include teaching Math for Elementary Teachers I and II (Math 2010 & Math 2020), Algebraic Reasoning with Modeling (Math 2000), Algebra for Secondary Mathematics Teaching (Math 3030), and lower-division mathematics courses as needed. UVU welcomes candidates whose experience in teaching, scholarship, or community service has prepared them to contribute to our commitment to diversity and inclusive excellence. Employment decisions are made on the basis of an applicant's qualifications and ability to perform the job without regard to race, color, religion, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression, age (40 and over), disability, veteran status, pregnancy, childbirth, or pregnancy-related conditions, genetic information, or other bases protected by applicable federal, state, or local law.
