

Doctoral Conference on Mathematics Education Announcement

A national conference on doctoral programs in mathematics education will be held September 23-25, 2020 in Las Vegas, NV. The three-day conference is funded by the National Science Foundation (No. 1932697) and will bring together faculty members actively involved in doctoral programs in mathematics education to discuss issues relevant to designing and implementing doctoral preparation. The two specific goals of the conference are to:

- Examine, discuss and update the *[Principles to Guide the Design and Implementation of Doctoral Programs in Mathematics Education](#)* that were initially published by AMTE and NCTM (2002).
- Collect/distribute current data related to niches in doctoral programs in mathematics education, and identify ways this information can be used throughout the mathematics education community.

Every effort will be made to have a diverse representation of faculty members from a wide range of doctoral programs in mathematics education although multiple participants from the same institution may be accepted.
