

VISITING ASSISTANT PROFESSOR, STEM EDUCATION

Position Summary:

The School of Education invites applications for a Visiting Assistant Professor in the School of Education within the College of Education, Criminal Justice, Human Services, and Information Technology (CECH) at the University of Cincinnati. Primary responsibilities will reside in the Curriculum and Instruction program. The position is expected to begin January, 2021 with an annual salary of \$65,000. This is a 1-year contract with an option to renew up to two times.

- Evaluate the current Curriculum & Instruction STEM Graduate Certificate program curriculum.
- Liaise between the Curriculum & Instruction program and UC Online to develop a marketing and recruitment plan.
- Course development in STEM Education.
- Teach graduate courses in STEM Education.

The successful candidate will teach on-line graduate courses in the Curriculum and Instruction Master's in Education and STEM Certificate programs; contribute to the development of STEM related pedagogical courses; and other duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Doctoral degree from an accredited institution in STEM education or a related field. All applicants must have a doctoral degree by January 1, 2021.
- Demonstrated capacity for successful teaching in higher education.
- Demonstrated capacity for successful scholarship.
- Demonstrated capacity for contribution to the service expectations.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Scholarly research activity related to integrated STEM education in K-16.
- Expertise in Special Education inclusion in STEM subjects.
- Experience teaching online.
- Demonstrated effectiveness working on collaborative teams.

- Knowledge, experience, or research that contributes to the university, college, and school mission statements.

Application Requirements:

All applicants should submit:

- A two-page cover letter describing how they meet the minimum and preferred qualifications described above, including sections related to teaching and, respectively, research
- Curriculum vitae
- A list of three names of professional references (complete with title, address, email address, and phone number)
- One example of scholarship (e.g., publication or conference presentation), if available.
